The WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL, as Waste Regulation Authority, in pursuance of their powers under part 1 of the Control of Pollution Act, 1974, hereby license Messrs. R. Bailey & P. Shirley of 1, Malt Mill Green, Kilsby, Nr. Rugby being the occupier of land at Rugby Fuel Supplies, Unit 17, Hunters Lane, Rugby CV21 1EA more particularly described in the application reference No. 443 dated 19th February 1992 (hereinafter called "the site") to deposit controlled waste on the site and to use plant or equipment on the site for the purpose of disposing of controlled waste or of dealing in a prescribed manner with controlled waste in accordance with the conditions set out below

Licensed Area and Working Plan

1. This licence shall apply to the site outlined in red on drawing number SS01 submitted with the waste disposal licence application.

2. (a) The statement of intended methods of operation, the drawing referenced SS01 and the letter dated 22nd September 1992 submitted as part of the application for this licence, together with any later drawings or written statements submitted to and approved by the Waste Regulation Authority (WRA), in substitute for, or in augmentation of, such drawings or statements, will hereinafter be referred to as the "working plan".

(b) The licence holder shall obtain written approval from the WRA for any proposed changes to the working plan, as altered by any previously approved changes, before the proposed changes are implemented.

(c) Subject to the terms of this licence, the site shall be operated in accordance with the working plan.

3. No deposit of waste shall take place until the requirements of conditions 6, 7, 8, 10 and 20 of this licence have been complied with, and the WRA has given its approval in writing that operations may commence.

Waste Types and Quantities

4. The types and quantities of waste that shall be deposited daily at the site shall not exceed the following:-

40 m³ of non hazardous household, industrial and commercial waste.

Note: Asbestos waste, liquid waste, or waste contained in drums shall not be deposited or stored at the site.

Hours of Operation

5. The hours of operation of the site shall not exceed the following:-

Monday to Sunday 07.30 hours to 18.00 hours

Site Infrastructure, Maintenance and Security

6.(a) No deposit shall take place until a notice board of not less than 1.0 square metre in area, and made of durable material and finish has been displayed at the site entrance, showing the hours when the site is open and giving the name of the site, the name, address and telephone number of the site operator and of the WRA responsible for issuing the site licence, and a telephone number to be used in case of emergency.

(b) This board shall be maintained in an effective and legible condition.

7. No deposit shall take place until gates have been provided as detailed in the working plan. These gates shall be kept securely locked in the closed position outside of operational hours or when the site is unattended.

8. No deposit shall take place until the whole perimeter of the site has been fenced to the standard detailed in the working plan in order to impede unauthorised access and prevent accidental access to the site.

9. The perimeter fence, gates and notice shall be inspected at least weekly by an employee of the licence holder and any damage observed shall be repaired by the end of the day on which it was observed. Details of these inspections shall be recorded in the site diary.

10. No deposit shall take place until a site control office has been provided in the location detailed in the working plan. The site control office shall provide the following :-

(a) Adequate heating and lighting.

- (b) A telephone.
- (c) First-Aid equipment.
- (d) A separate messroom for use when required.
- (e) A washbasin with hot and cold water.
- (f) Toilet.

These facilities shall be maintained in an effective condition.

The office shall hold the site records and documents required by conditions 22 and 24 of this licence.

1-1: (a) All tanks used for the storage of fuel shall be sited within containment compounds constructed of impermeable materials. The compounds must be capable of containing the capacity of the largest tank, plus 10%. A marker shall be provided within the compound which shall clearly indicate when there is less than 100% of the tank capacity left in the bund. When this level is reached, immediate action shall be taken to remove the liquid contained in the compound.

(b) Any tank used for fuel storage shall be of a type and construction suitable for its purpose, and shall be clearly labelled to show its contents and its capacity.

(c) All off-loading valves and vent pipes shall be sited within the containment compound such that any spillages are contained within the compound.

(d) The delivery hose of any fuel tank shall have an in-line valve which shall be kept closed and locked when the site is unmanned.

(e) All tanks used for the storage of gas oil shall be fitted with reliable level monitoring devices located inside the compound.

(f) If the containment compound is of a walled bund type, there shall not be a free draining valve from the bund. Any valve present shall be kept closed and locked and shall only be opened upon the instructions of the site manager following inspection of the contents.

(g) All tanks and their associated bunds shall be inspected in accordance with the details contained in the working plan.

12. (a) The site shall be surfaced to the standard detailed in the working plan. The roads shall be kept free of mud or other debris to the extent necessary to prevent fouling of the public highway.

(b) The roads of the licensed site shall be inspected weekly and any potholes that develop shall be repaired within 14 working days of being identified.

13. No deposit shall take place during the hours of darkness, as defined by the statutory vehicle lighting up times, published by the Science and Engineering Research Council, unless adequate lighting is used and maintained to illuminate all the operating areas of the facility.

14. Drainage shall be provided and maintained as detailed in the working plan.

15. The surfaces and walls of the tipping area shall be inspected at least weekly. Any defects noted shall be reported to the site supervisor and a course of remedial action implemented. Details of these inspections shall be recorded in the site diary.

16. The surface of the site shall be kept clean and free of oils and grease to ensure a safe working environment. Any liquid spillages which occur shall be dealt with immediately. A supply of suitably absorbent material shall be maintained on site for this purpose.

17. Plant and machinery requiring specialist maintenance shall be serviced by suitably qualified personnel at a frequency recommended by the manufacturer.

Record Keeping, Manning and Supervision

18. The site shall be manned by at least one person during all periods of operation.

19. The site shall be supervised by a person competent and qualified to ensure compliance with this licence. This person shall inspect the site each working day and record the inspection on a format approved by the WRA.

20. No deposit shall take place until the WRA have been informed, in writing, of the names of those persons who shall be manning the site, and the name of the person who shall be responsible for supervising the site. This information shall be submitted to form part of the working plan.

21. The reception of vehicles delivering waste to the site shall be as detailed in the working plan.

22. A daily record shall be kept of all vehicles delivering waste to the site, along with the type, origin, and quantity of waste delivered. Records shall also be kept of all wastes removed from the site detailing quantity and point of final disposal. These records shall be kept at the site control office and be available for inspection during working hours by any authorised officer of the WRA.

23. At the end of each calendar month a summary of waste deposited at the site shall be forwarded to the WRA on an approved format, to arrive not later than 14 days following the end of the month.

24.(a) A site diary of a format approved by the WRA shall be kept in the site control office and be maintained daily to record the details required by Conditions 9, 15, 32, 33, 34 and 36 of this licence.

(b) This diary shall be available for inspection by any authorised officer of the WRA.

Waste Handling, Processing and Storage

25. Waste shall only be deposited and stored in the area outlined in green on the drawing No SS01.

26. The maximum quantities of waste to be stored on site pending removal shall not exceed the following:-

(a) 40 m³ of non hazardous household, industrial and commercial waste.

(b) 20 m³ of scrap metal and building materials.

27. All wastes shall be handled in accordance with the procedures detailed in the working plan.

28. Any waste remaining in the receiving bay at the end of the day shall be placed in skips for storage overnight. These skips shall be netted or sheeted.

29. Waste shall be moved from the tipping bays as soon as is practical, and within 4 working days of deposit.

30. Scrap metal and other reclaimed materials shall be removed off-site within one month of being deposited.

31. Waste shall not be allowed to accumulate to levels higher than three metres above ground level, or to levels causing waste to overspill from the tipping bays.

32.(a) Should any waste not permitted by this licence, or which may be considered to be hazardous, be identified, then this waste shall be isolated and the site supervisor and the WRA informed immediately.

(b) Following prior approval by the WRA, a course of action to deal with the waste shall be immediately implemented. Details of any such incidents shall be recorded in the site diary.

Control of Litter, Fire and Pests

33.(a) A daily inspection shall be undertaken for windblown litter not arrested by the perimeter fencing. Details of these inspections shall be recorded in the site diary.

(b) Any windblown material carried off site shall be collected and disposed of forthwith.

(c) Any windblown material and loose waste lying within the site shall be gathered and disposed of as soon as practicable, and not less frequently than twice a week.

34. No waste or other material shall be burnt within the site boundary and a fire at the site shall be regarded as an emergency, with immediate action being taken to extinguish it. Any fire shall be notified forthwith to the Fire Services and the WRA and details recorded in the site diary.

35. Fire fighting facilities shall be provided on site. The location of these shall be forwarded to the WRA within one month of the issue of this licence. These facilities shall be maintained in accordance with the manufacturers recommendations.

36. The site shall be inspected for vermin by a suitably qualified person at least once a month. Steps shall be taken to irradiate any infestation of vermin that may occur. Details of these inspections shall be recorded in the site diary.

General

37. Any temporary cessation of operations for a period of more than one month shall be notified to the WRA.

38. No less than 5 days notice, in writing, shall be given to the WRA of the date on which operations are to commence, or, in the event of a temporary cessation for a period in excess of one month, recommence.

39. The terms of the site licence shall be made known to any person who is given responsibility for the management; supervision or control of the site. A copy of this licence and the working plan shall be displayed at the site office and so that they can be seen by the licence holders employees and any visitors to the site.

40. The activities to which this licence relates shall not be so carried on as to cause pollution of water, or danger to public health, or become seriously detrimental to the amenities of the locality affected by the activities.

The reasons for the Council's decision to impose conditions on the use of the site for the operations hereby licensed are:-

To ensure that waste disposal is carried out with no unacceptable risk to the environment and to public health safety and amenity.

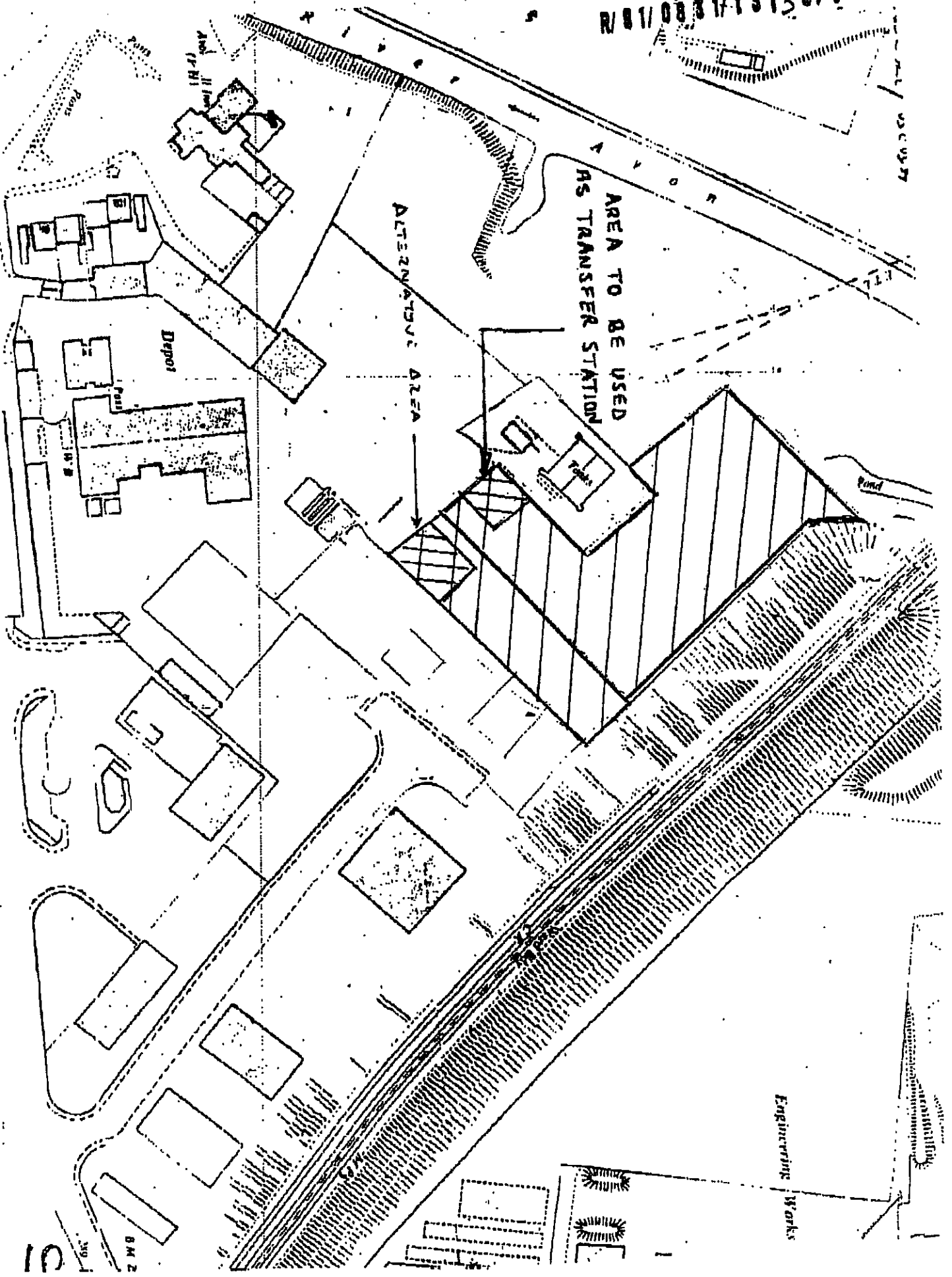

The Secretary of State has power to allow a longer period for the giving of notice of an appeal but he will not normally be prepared to exercise this power unless there are special circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of an appeal.
