Carbon Neutral Company

Fortress continues to strive to reduce our carbon footprint; however there are areas of our operation where the technology is not yet reliable enough for us to switch to low carbon alternatives. Carbon Offsets can be used to compensate for the emissions produced by funding an equivalent carbon dioxide saving elsewhere. Fortress has supported various renewable energy projects around the world as part of its carbon neutral offsets for the last 5 years and in 2016 we launched 'Fortress For Trees'; a project that is fighting to save the Amazonian Rainforest in Brazil.

Community Support

Fortress is a family-run business that operates across the West Midlands region. We recognize that our company is part of the fabric of our local area, providing employment and a vital service to local businesses and organisations.
